SRI MUKTSAR SAHIB

Sri Muktsar Sahib, a historic city in Punjab, is renowned for the Battle of Muktsar (1705), where Guru Gobind Singh's warriors attained martyrdom and liberation. Named after this event, "Muktsar" means "the pool of liberation," honoring the Chali Mukte (Forty Liberated Ones).

Today, it is a major Sikh pilgrimage site, home to Gurdwara Sri Muktsar Sahib and the annual Maghi Mela. Beyond its religious and historical significance, the city serves as an educational hub, with institutions like Doon International School shaping future generations.

THE SCHOOL PHILOSOPHY

EXAMINATIONS

Examinations may not be the true test of a child's ability but regular classroom tests and periodic examinations at the school level are indicative of scholastic achievement. The results enable the class teachers as well as the students to reassess their orientation and take corrective steps to accord due attention to subjects and topics in which the child may not have been found up to expectations. Apart from monthly tests, results of which are also intimated to the parents, examinations are organized as per the following schedule:



All students must submit a certificate of fitness issued by the physician at the time of joining school. The parents must also submit dental and eye checkup report. The child must be vaccinated as per the schedule recommended by the World Health Organization (WHO).

If for any reason a child has missed on some vaccinations, the same must be brought to the notice of the school authorities, so that arrangements may be made by the school. Primary vaccinations and status of Boosters should also be intimated.

Children who are under any prolonged line of treatment must bring along a detailed summary and prescription by the treating doctor enabling the school medical compounder to take charge of the same. All medicines or tonics should be handed over to the Nurse in-charge of the MI Room.

The school has an expert panel of specialist doctors to handle all medical situations to ensure that children are provided the best medical treatment if need be. The Parents/Guardians must not have any objection to their child/ward being offered emergency medical help or surgery if the same is advised by medical experts.

The school takes particular care of the medical well-being and health of the children and their diet is constantly reviewed, supervised, inspected and revised.



ADMISSION & APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Parents/ Guardians should register their children for admission to the relevant class by completing and submitting the application form provided with the prospectus. All the instructions mentioned in the form must be strictly followed.

Once the child is registered with the school, the school's Admission Committee will revert to the Parent /Guardian with details on the admission procedure to be followed. Registration is not a guarantee of Admission to the school and the registration fees is not refundable. Admission would be offered only to those children who complete the criteria set by the school and are considered eligible by the Admissions Committee of the school. Once an offer for admission is made, the same must be acknowledged and the admission formalities must be completed in the time frame mentioned in the admission letter failing which the seat would be offered to the next eligible candidate.

INFORMATION FOR OVERSEAS APPLICANTS

The procedure for admission for overseas and foreign applicants remains the same. However foreign passport holders are required to obtain a student's visa from the Indian Embassy/Consulate in their country. They can apply for the visa once their application for admission has been approved by the school's Admissions Committee and a letter confirming admission is issued to the applicant. The visa must be for the tenure of the student's education at the school.

The Admission/Registration Form must be accompanied by the documents listed below:

- i. Mark Sheet of the last session attended in current school
- ii. Transfer Certificate in original (class 1 onwards, after confirmation of admission)
- iii. Character Certificate (Class VIII onwards, after confirmation of admission)
- iv. Migration Certificate (for Class XI & XII)
- v. Copy of Birth Certificate and Adhaar Card
- vi. Copy of Visitor's / Local Guardian's ID Card

 (To enable the Hostel Incharges to send the wards for outings with authorized guardians only)
- vii. Medical Fitness Certificate with Blood Group
- viii. Six Passport size Photographs
- ix. Copy of the Passport (in case of foreign applicants)



FEE REGULATIONS

The school has two terms – April to September which is the first term and October to March which is the second term. Fee is payable in advance at the beginning of each term. The school will issue a statement of dues for incidental expenses incurred by the child at the end of each term to the parents and fees must be paid within four weeks of issue of account statement by the School Accounts Office. Late fees would be payable as per school rules if the outstanding dues are not paid on time.

Fee is charged from the beginning of each term irrespective of the joining date of the child. If a child is withdrawn mid-term, the fees for the entire term would be payable.

- Students will not be allowed to return to school after the vacations, unless the accounts for previous school term has been settled in full. No reduction is allowed for broken periods. All dues must be cleared before the child leaves the school.
- The school fee is increased annually and the same shall be applicable to all students.
- The school reserves the right to initiate legal action to recover outstanding dues, from parents who withdraw their child from school without clearing outstanding payments.
- All disputes will be subject to the jurisdiction of Sri Muktsar Sahib courts only.



WITHDRAWALS

The school aims at excellence in all spheres connected with educating and bringing up children. We are confident that except for purely personal or family reasons, a child will not be withdrawn until he/she has completed his/her schooling.

However in case it becomes imperative to withdraw the child, a minimum notice of three months must be given to the school, failing which three months fees will be forfeited/charged in lieu of notice. No fees would be refunded for mid-term withdrawal. The security deposit paid to the school at the time of admission is refunded to the parents three months after withdrawal.

SCHOOL RULES & REGULATIONS

- The school shall inform the Parents/Guardians about the academic, health, behavior, conduct and any other relevant development at regular intervals.
- The school has the full authority to suspend/terminate from school any child on disciplinary or academic grounds if the same is found necessary in the interest of the child and/or school.
- Children are not allowed to keep cash/valuables/jewelry in school.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited as the school provides telephones and other communication facilities to the children. Hence if any child is found in possession of a mobile phone, the same will be confiscated and not returned.
- Parents must not give any gifts in cash or kind to any staff member of the school.
- Permission to attend special functions at home shall usually not be granted, as a safeguard both for study and health.
- The school must be provided with details of visitors authorized by the parents to visit their children in writing. Only those whose names are on the visitors list will be permitted to meet the students. Any visitor not on the list must bring a letter of authority from the parents.
- The school is very particular about punctuality. Any child reporting late to school would be fined as per school rules and the amount collected would be donated for charity.
- The school provides nourishing wholesome meals on campus.
- The school organizes additional help in subjects that a child may be facing difficulty with on the request of parents. Please route such requests to the Principal so that necessary arrangements may be made.
- When permitted to go out, children must be accompanied by their parents or by some duly authorized person.
